**Piano Club
Awards Competition
April 30, 2022**

To be eligible, you must perform at least once at Piano Club, attend at least two meetings, and pay the \$10.00 registration fee.

Your teacher must be a member of the Holland Piano Teachers Forum.

You will perform two memorized pieces for a guest artist in a recital setting.

One piece must focus on a composer from underrepresented group (e.g. . Black, Asian, Latino, women, etc.) The second piece is your choice. Students should play original music rather than arrangements.

The students will compete at Elementary (grades K-4th), Intermediate (grades 5th-8th), and Senior (9th-12th) Levels.

Two monetary prizes will be awarded at each of the three levels: \$25 (1st) and \$15 (2nd). Levels with more than 8 performers will also award a 3rd place Honorable Mention Certificate.

The competition will be held April 30, 2022 at 1st Reformed Church of Holland.

About Holland Piano Club

- Piano Club is open to students of Holland Piano Teachers Forum members.
- The annual enrollment fee is \$10.
- Club members attend four Friday meetings to listen or to perform. It's a great way to meet other piano students and hear new pieces.
- The first Club meeting will focus on ensembles (music allowed). Subsequent meetings will emphasize memorized solos. Students will perform at least one time.
- As Piano Club members, students earn points toward recognition at the February meeting.
- Every time a student performs, he/she will receive a ribbon. At the last meeting, students who have attended at least two club recitals, and who have performed at least once, will receive a certificate. Students with perfect attendance who have performed at least once will receive a certificate with a gold seal.
